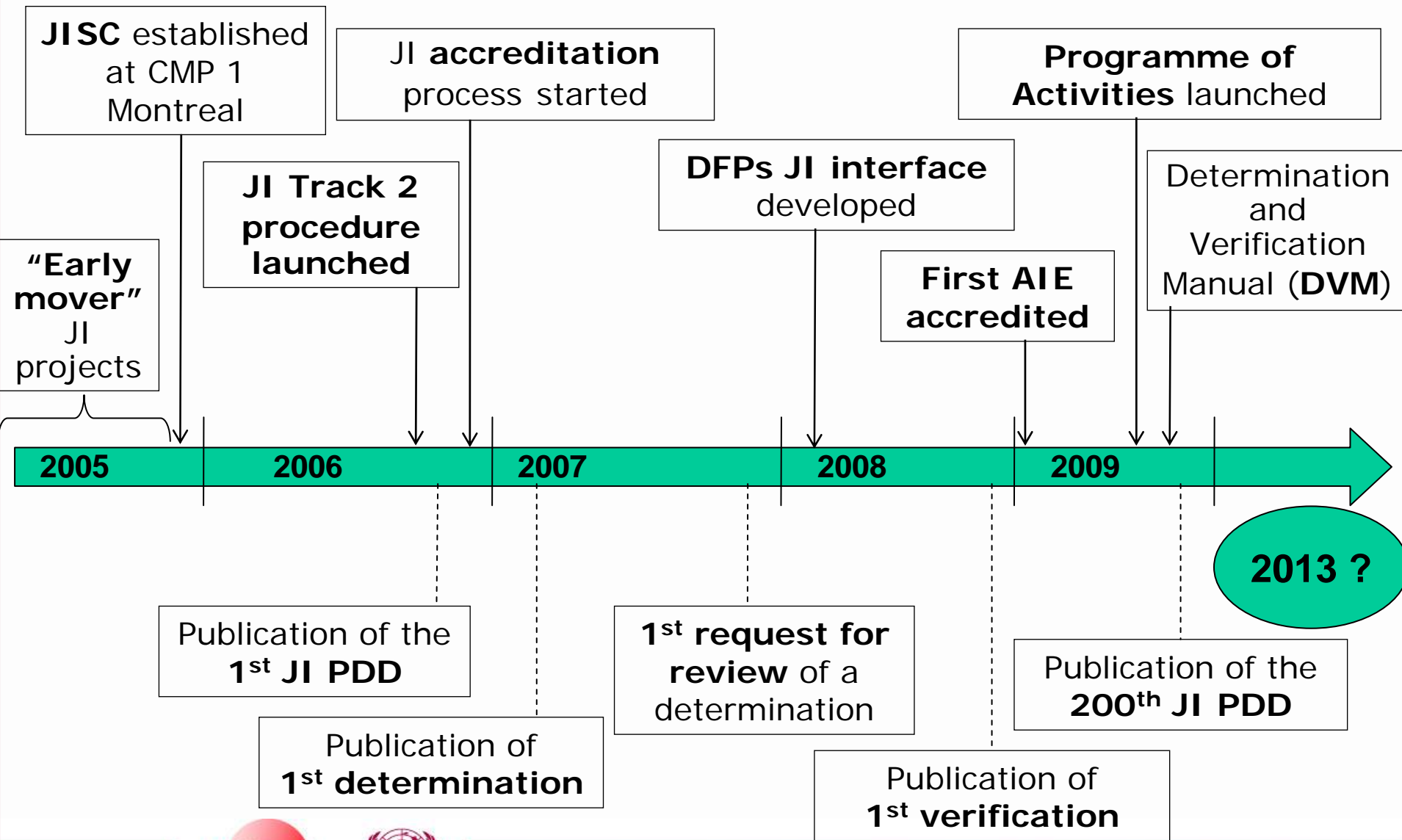

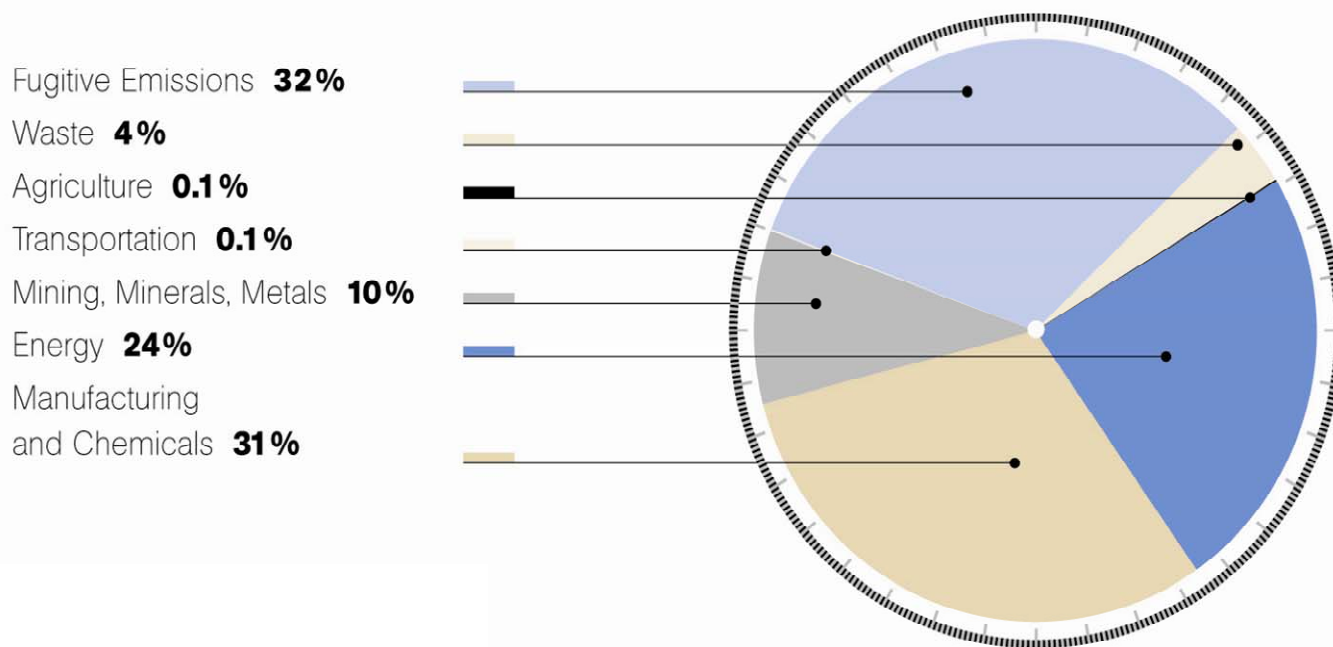

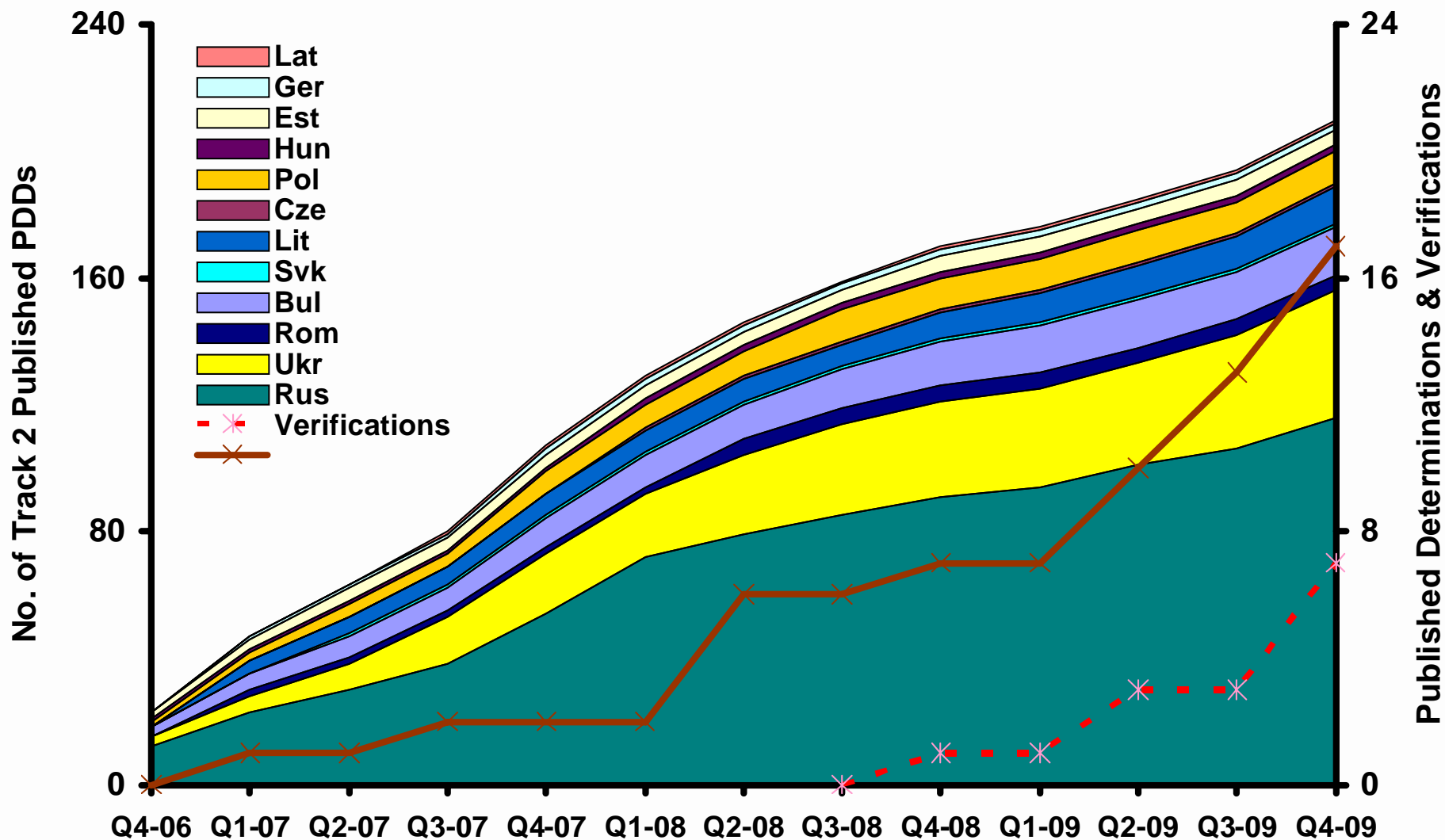
JI Status – Emission Reductions by Scope

212 JI Track 2 project design documents (PDDs) published on UNFCCC JI website with emission reductions of approximately **325 Mt CO₂** equivalent during the 1st CP (**2008-2012**) covering **13 sectoral scopes**

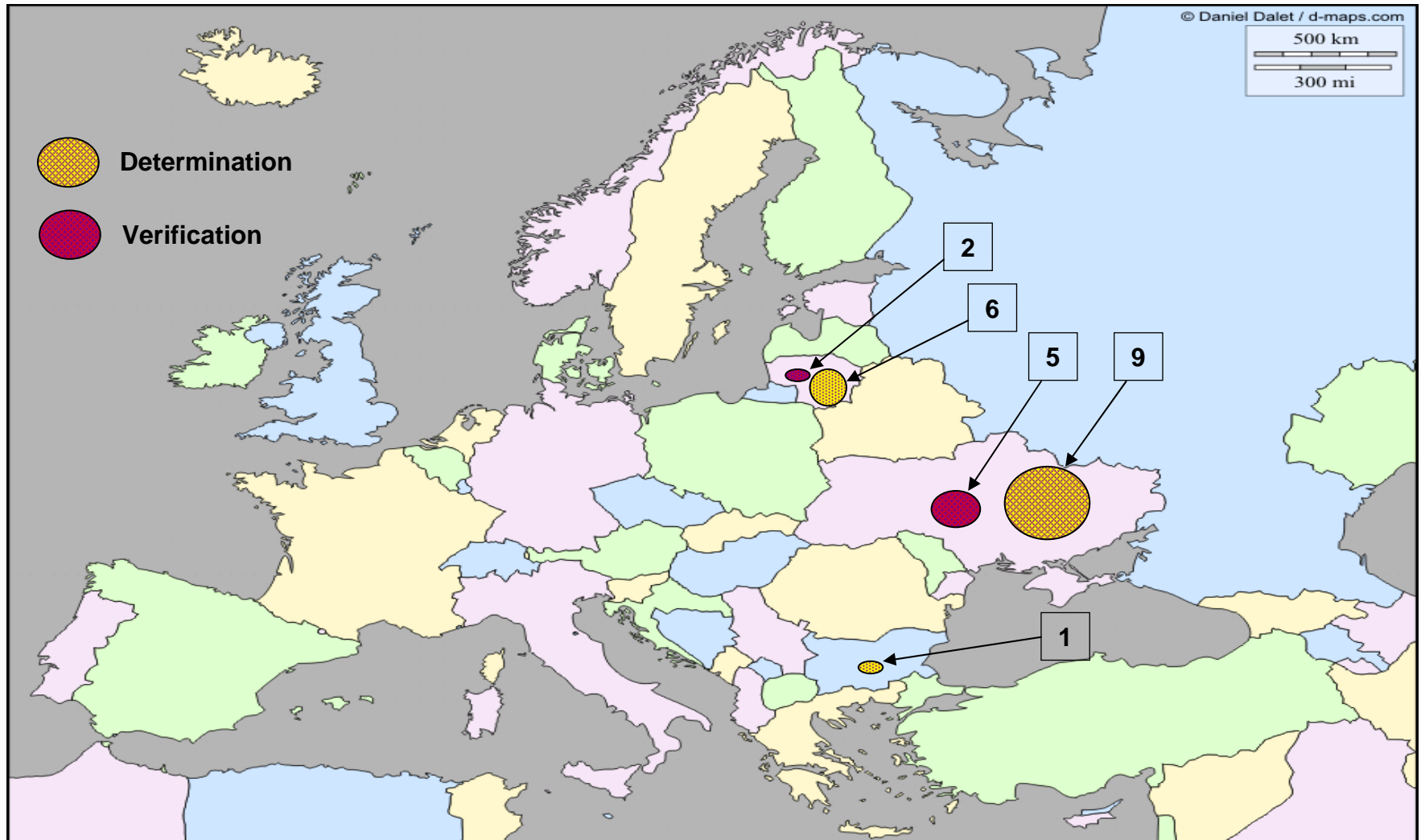
JI Track 2 industries (submitted project proposals by expected GHG reduction)



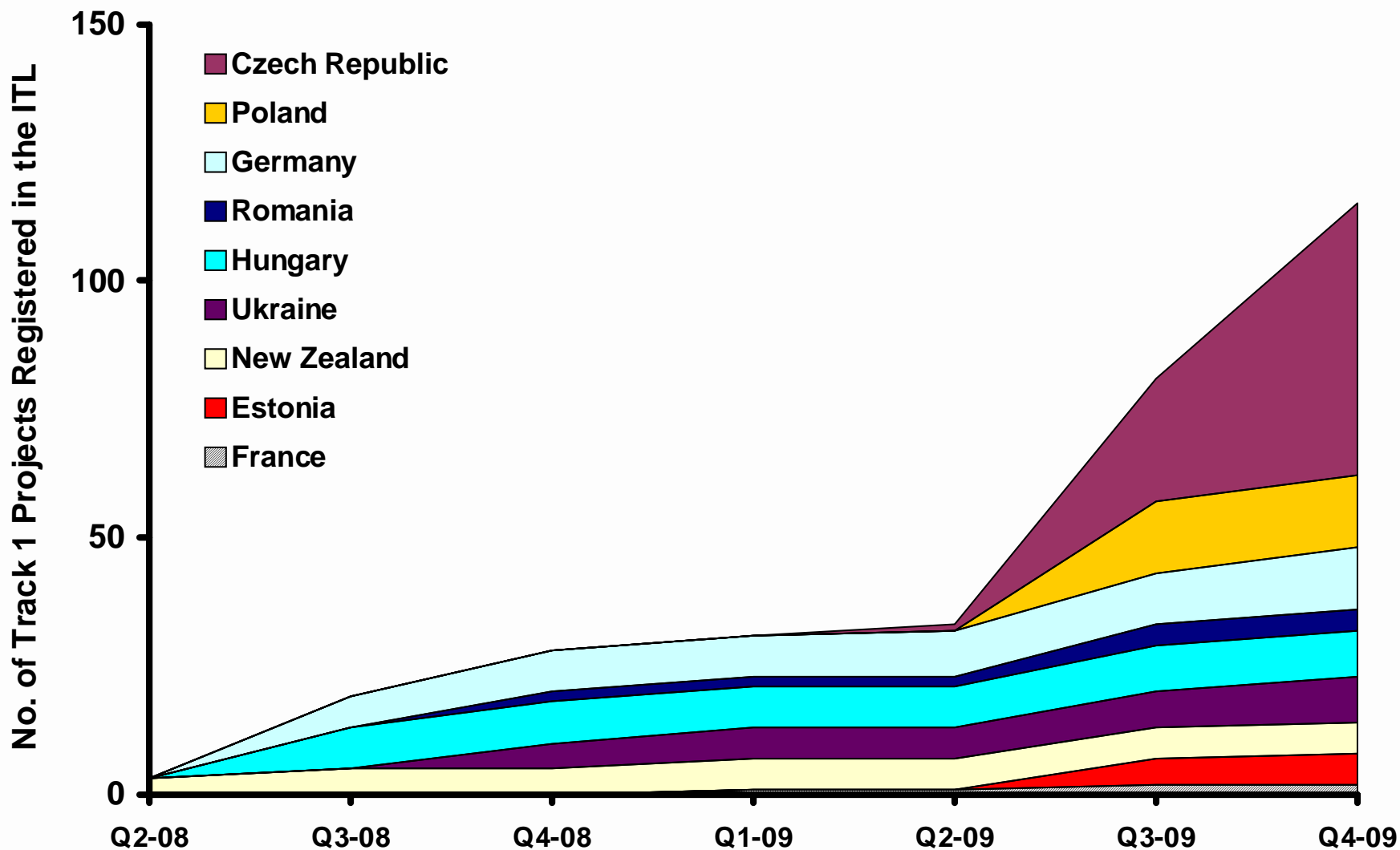
JI Status – Track 2 PDDs, Determinations, Verifications

JI Status – Accreditation Process

- **JISC** decided (2nd meeting) to establish its **accreditation panel** (JI-AP)
- **JISC** accredits entities for “**third party**” **determination of PDDs** and **verification of emission reductions** units (ERUs)
- **3 Independent Entities** (IEs) already accredited → **AIEs**
- **13 applicant IEs** in the process of accreditation
- **8 applicant IEs (DOEs)** may act **provisionally** as AIEs (*det./ver. not final*)
- accreditation based on **sectoral scopes**
- **5 year accreditation term** with a regular on-site surveillance at mid-term
- **stringent accreditation and competent AIEs ensure the JI integrity**

Copenhagen Decision on JI and JISC

CMP 5 considered the JISC's annual report and JISC Chair's oral report and adopted **a decision** on JI guidance, **encouraging JISC** to:

- further enhance its **interaction with DFPs, AIEs, PPs and stakeholders**
- conduct an **assessment of the implications** of possible inclusion of the concepts of **materiality and level of assurance** in JI determinations/verifications
- **report to the CMP 6 on its experiences** with the JI verification procedure
- enhance **outreach activities** to improve overall understanding of JI (+ secretariat)

IEs encouraged to continue **to build and improve their capacity** to appropriately perform their functions under the verification procedure

Secretariat and **DFPs** requested **to improve the web-based interface** for JI by standardizing the information for JI Track 1 projects (e.g. minimum amount required)

A1 Parties urged **to make contributions** for funding the work on JI in 2010-2011



JI in Post-2012 Regime

- JI mechanism is **flexible** and **can adapt** to different post-2012 regimes
- JI **characteristics** post 2012 are **still to be determined** but likely to start with the existing **guidelines**
- JI is a **proven mechanism** supported by **investors** and **host countries**
- Most JI projects have an **economic life** extending **10-25 years**, providing ERU supply beyond 2012



JI Track 2 project “Utilization of CMM at Coal Mine named after A.F.Zasyadko” (0035) – provided verified emission reductions of approximately 1,135,000 tonnes of CO₂e

Closing Remarks

- **Momentum** for JI Track 2 appears to be **strengthening**
- Expected **ERU** supply **increase** in 2010-12 - depending on many factors
- **JI programmes of activities** (PoA) approved 2009 - new tool to facilitate JI
- **Determination and verification manual** (DVM) approved 2009 - support IEs to conduct project appraisals in a **consistent manner**
- **New accreditations** of IEs in 2010 may increase **project and ERU supply**
- **Financial support** for JI remains **challenging** but may increase depending on the number of projects moving towards determination/verification
- **Main activities in 2010**
 - Continued consideration of **determinations/verifications**
 - Further improvements of **procedures and guidance** documents
 - Improvement of the **web-based interface** for JI Track 1 and Track 2
